The Scholarship Committee is now accepting applications for the scholarships listed below.

Awards of at least five hundred dollars (\$500) will be given to qualified students to use toward furthering his/her education. **Applications are due by April 30th 12:00 noon.**

To qualify, all applicants must:

- Be a member of Nazarene Baptist Church for a minimum of two years.
- Be active in a youth ministry.
- Have a “B” average or above.
*“Please include **official** proof of grades and college acceptance letter with application”*
- Submit 400-500 word typed essay (see topics below).
No longer than (2) pages, 8 1/2 x 11, double spaced.
MLA format (Applicant’s name, address, contact information on each page)
- Submit two letters of recommendation; one letter should be from a family member.

Please check the box to the right indicating which scholarship you are applying for. Please note you can apply for more than one scholarship, but only one scholarship will be awarded per student.

Candidates will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee for interviews.

Candidates awarded scholarships must submit proof of enrollment **(Official Enrollment Certification from the Office of the Registrar) by October 15th**, before funds are released.

INGRAM FAMILY VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applicant must:

1. be starting eleventh grade or higher or currently enrolled in a vocational or trade program full time
2. be under age of 21
3. Only one award issued per year / per family during academic career
4. submit a short (1-2 page) hand written or typed essay regarding the topic "What interests me in vocational training versus a "college" and what do I plan to do with my training to help my church"
5. submit a letter of recommendation (with signatures) from the principal or authorized "hands on" teacher or staff member of their current school
6. submit a complete, official transcript reflecting roster, cumulative passing GPA
7. submit a record of attendance (if not already listed on official transcript)
8. applicants who are currently enrolled in a vocational or trade program must submit a letter from the Dean or Advisor as well as #s 5 through 7 above
9. the educational facility must be an accredited school or program and must be registered with the Department of Labor in the state where the school is located
10. submit a letter of intent to apply (to scholarship committee) no later than June 15th

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applicant must:

1. attend an undergraduate college or university accredited by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA)
2. have successfully completed 1 year at a CHEA school having a GPA of 3.25 or higher on a 4.0 grading scale
3. submit an official transcript with a raised seal
4. submit a 2-3 page, typed, double spaced essay regarding "How achieving my educational goals will benefit society (as a whole) and the mission of the church"
5. for undergraduates, provide proof of receipt of a Pell Grant Award for upcoming semester(s) from the US Department of Education

INEZ JONES COOKE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applicant must:

1. be a high school graduate with plans to study medical disciplines or currently enrolled in college majoring in medical disciplines
2. have a "B" average
3. submit an official transcript with a raised seal (for high school graduates)
4. submit a 2-3 page, typed, double spaced essay regarding "How I will apply my medical training to meet the needs of individuals both physically and spiritually"
